

Smoking

The school has a strict "No smoking" policy. Staff should leave the school site if they wish to smoke at break or lunch time.

When out on trips, staff must ensure that no person is put at risk should a cigarette break be granted. Staff pupil ration must be maintained at all times.

Safeguarding and Security Arrangements

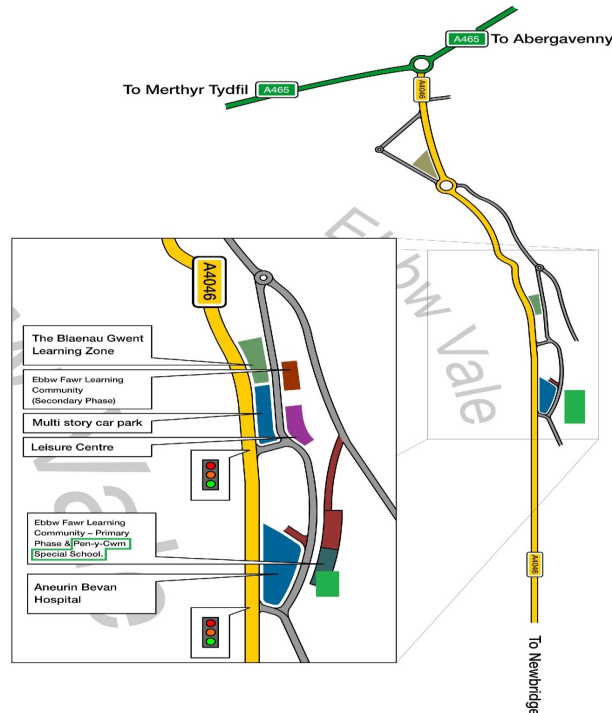
The school has a fob security system. Fobs will be issued to placement students or volunteers at reception when you sign in and **MUST** be returned daily.

A professional manner is expected at all times. Sensitive and confidential information must not be discussed out of school.

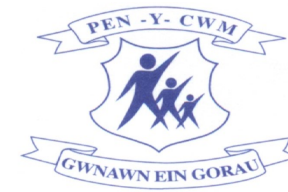
Pen-y-Cwm is a day school for pupils aged three to nineteen years who have a range of severe learning difficulties and in a number of cases profound and multiple learning difficulties. Many of the pupils have additional difficulties such as physical and/or sensory impairment or have autistic spectrum disorder. Some pupils have significant medical difficulties and need full or part-time nursing support throughout the school day.

Outline of School Day

Students/Volunteers need to be in school for 0830

Report to main reception.

Sign in and you will be issued with a fob.

Pupils will begin arriving from 0850

Students/Volunteers are entitled to a 15 minute morning break as advised by the class teacher.

Lunchtime is between 1130-1230

Primary pupils being leaving school from 1450 and secondary pupils from 1500

Transport arrangements at the school

Most, if not all of the pupils at Pen-y-Cwm Special School are transported to and from school on mini-buses or taxies. The procedure of loading/unloading pupils must be carried out as safely and efficiently as possible.

Car Parking

Please refrain from parking in the minibus and disabled bays. Please park in the main car park and sign in at reception.

Lunchtimes

Teaching assistants, students and volunteers are entitled to a 30 minutes lunch break.

Students/volunteers are not permitted in the staff room but may take breaks in the bistro area.

Confidentiality

All staff are reminded of the need for confidentiality in all matters relating to school or individual pupils.

Breaches of confidentiality will be taken very seriously.

Absence

In the event of absence, please telephone the school to inform them of your absence.

Telephone

Staff should ensure that all mobile telephones are switched off during teaching time. Mobiles are not permitted in classrooms. Calls on mobiles should be made or received at break and lunchtime only.
